Tribal consultations work to honor the government-to-government relationship between tribes and the Department of Education by providing tribal leaders and participants an opportunity to engage in dialogue with senior officials from the Department of Education about the critical issues facing American Indian and Alaska Native students. Information gathered from these sessions informs Federal education programs and policies that aim to improve outcomes for all American Indian and Alaska Native students.
